## Notice of pipeline diversion works off Gilson Road, south of Gilson

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current COVID-19 strategy makes clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance. The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we affect is our key priority. Please be assured that those sites that are currently still working are doing so because they can operate within PHE and construction industry guidelines.

To continue to ensure a safe and reliable gas supply during HS2's construction and ongoing operation, Cadent will be diverting a gas pipeline on land off Gilson Road, south of Gilson.

Work will start in September 2020 and we expect to complete most work by the end of 2020. Depending on weather, we may need to return to carry out some final reinstatement works in 2021. We will keep local people up to date as our work progresses.

### What are we doing?

We will be starting site set-up and main work to move the pipeline in early September 2020. The work will involve:

- Setting up a temporary works compound on land off Gilson Road, south of Gilson
- Installing fencing around our working area
- Site preparations including the removal of some vegetation
- Digging a trench for the new pipeline route
- Welding the pipe together then installing it in the trench
- Connecting and testing the new pipe

There will be 24-hour security on site so we can maintain a safe working environment. There will be no workers accommodation on-site.

### How will this affect you?

Construction vehicles will be accessing the site off the A446 and Gilson Road, through the existing HS2 works compound east of Gilson Drive. Standard construction equipment will be used, and all work will take place inside usual working hours. There will not be any disruption to your utilities during our works.

- Early September 2020 until 31 December 2020
- Our working hours will be 8.00am to 6.00pm (Mon-Fri)
- We will be on-site one hour either side of these times for set-up and close-down

### What to expect

- Construction vehicles will access the site via the existing HS2 compound and access off Gilson Road, east of Gilson Drive
- 24-hour security on-site
- No road or footpath closures currently planned

### What we will do

- Make sure all construction vehicles use agreed routes
- Maintain a safe working environment
- Inform people in advance of any changes
